<p>Advertisements for logs in gdplogd have not been refreshed, so if the routing layer "loses" a route it is never restored (at least not until gdplogd or the router are restarted). They should be refreshed on a regular basis.</p> <p>This is a "placeholder" issue, because the work has already been completed. There is a companion issue where the router should really expire routes that have not been refreshed, but this is much lower priority.</p>
